May 2010 Cultural Diversity in Greece

PROGRAM

Students will be expected to arrive at Athens Airport no later than 5 p.m. local time on May 11, 2009. The program begins in Athens with a quick walking tour to a Taverna



for a Welcome Dinner and orientation of the itinerary and an early night. The next day a guided tour will take us for a first hand look at the Acropolis, the Parthenon, Athena Nike Temple, and both the Erechtheon and Propylaea. A second day

in Athens finds us at the Parliament and the Temple of Poseidon at Cape Souino for dinner. We will venture out of Athens to Kalamaka, Delphi Santorini, Oia, Piraeus and Nauplion (Sparta). The end of the program finds us back in Athens with stops at Mycenae and Epidaurus. We will say goodbye at a Farewell Dinner near our hotel. Students will find their way back to the Athens Airport. Instructors will arrive in Athens one day early. We will work with students who would like to fly together to arrange group airfare/flights.

PROGRAM DIRECTORS

This course will be taught by Dr. Kami Schwerdtfeger, Assistant Professor of Marriage and Family Therapy and Ms. Anne Mahoney, Outreach Coordinator for the College of Human Environmental Sciences.

SAMPLE ITINERARY

Athens: Orientation and Welcome Dinner, guided tour of the Acropolis, Ancient Agora, Temple of Poseidon, Parliament

Kalama: Guided tour of Meteor, Aiga Triada Monastery (featured in the James Bond movie "For Your Eyes Only")

Delphi: Archaeological site and museum and Chietmoutsi Castle

Piraeous: Third largest passenger seaport in the world. We will take a high speed ferry to Santorini

Santorini: Private cruise with a guided visit to Caldera and the village of Oia

Nauplion: Guided tour to Sparta (the Sparta Acropolis and the Sparta Museum) and Mystras

Athens: Mycenae and Epidaurus, Temple of Athena, Farewell Dinner

A more detailed itinerary will be provided if requested.



COURSE OFFERED

(H, I)*HES 3080.606. International Experience. Through readings, museum visits and guided walking tours, students will come to understand the complex nature of cultural diversity. Students will be responsible for oral presentations and written reports as well as an extensive journal documenting their course experience.

ACCOMODATIONS

Students will stay in 3-star, comfortable but modest, hotels. Two students per room unless a single is requested and a single supplement is paid. All rooms will have private baths. Daily breakfast is provided as well as a Welcome Dinner, Farewell Dinner and a dinner while in Santorini.

Open to all students enrolled in an accredited U.S. college or university. Minimum 2.0 GPA required.
